Michael Barone wrote a piece in the Wall Street Journal titled "How ObamaCare Misreads America". In that, Mr. Barone lists several assumptions Obama&Co made, designing this masterpiece. Mr. Barone is an excellent writer, but in this piece, he missed the mark by a mile. A statement ("...apparent failures to anticipate the behavior of fellow citizens...") in his last paragraph clearly shows, he feels something is missing, or the piece has not reached full depth. His observation is correct, because he has not gone into full depth.

I have been writing for years about the modus operandi flowchart for socialist liberals, but let me recap here:

- 1) Imagine (-dream up) a perfect system, by completely disregarding facts, reasons, common sense, logic, and most of all, the "basic human element" factor;
- 2) Get pissed, arrogant, "I dunno", and start to practice boldfaced lie, when the populous does not comply, and your dream does not work;
- 3) If the populous still does not comply, get forceful, using "end justifies the means" tactics which in the majority of cases contains lawlessness, and even gangster elements;
- 4) When the entire system collapses, get defensive and take another "I dunno" cover.

To see where Obama&Co is, let's review some history.

Between 1917-1989 people across nine time zones were actually thought in schools, that they live in socialism, and work toward communism. They were thought Carl Marx's theory, that in communism, everyone works based upon the person's abilities, and consumes based upon the person's needs. Therefore, in communism, we will not use money. People will wear a pair of shoes, and when the shoes fall apart, walk into a shoe store and take another pair off the shelf (I am not making this up; you cannot make up this level of idiocy). The obvious (I mean: "obvious" to everyone but to those who imagined this) component they left out was the "human element"; the fact that there might be people who don't want to work based upon their "abilities", and people who might want more than one pair of shoes. It didn't take long for these social-liberal numnuts to find another venue. They called it the "European" Union". The story is well known by everyone, even by people who don't know more than the EU is in deep trouble, that Spain has 32% unemployment, that Greece is on the constant verge of bankruptcy, and so on (I wrote more than a dozen pieces on the topic). But the aspect that belongs here, as follows: the close to eight decade worth of Marxist experiment was not enough to this always dreaming social liberal crowd in Europe, so they thought they will take another whack at it. Apparently, no one in Europe heard the "Definition of insanity is to do the same over and over again, expecting different results" mantra, and they never heard Einstein's observation that "You cannot start to solve a problem in the same way, the problem was caused in the first place". Without going into details, these social liberals in Europe assumed (where did I here this word last?? ....Yes! And the German populous is getting mighty

pissed about the situation. All (let me repeat: <u>A-L-L</u>) because these social-liberals –again- forgot the "human element". That Greeks will always be fun people but will always "take care the number one", that Italians love three hour lunch, that a Frenchman will die (or start a revolution) before he will work a minute over 35 hour a week. These idiots also forgot, that this is how it suppose to work, because we are different. And this difference is the very beauty of the human nature.

...which brings us to Obama&Co, and ObamaCare (which is anything but -I am talking about the "care" part).

Aside of all the mindless arrogance and gangsterism, these social-liberal glazed-eyed sleepwalkers followed the exact flowchart which already caused 25 million dead people, a misery of 700 million, then –in another attempt- imposed a never seen before economic and social hardship on 320 million people. In other words, we spend 2.8 trillion taxpayer dollars in ten years to generate 1 million additional people with no health insurance whatsoever. Should someone be in jail?? Just a question.
- I have been holding on to the concept, that there are only two kinds of "preexisting condition": stupidity and economic hardship. Stupidity, when you can afford insurance but don't have one, and economic hardship when you cannot afford it. You cannot be cured from stupidity; you have to grow out of it on your own. If you have economic hardship, society needs to help you. The "I was insured, have breast cancer, was fired from my job and now I cannot get insurance" is <u>not</u>a preexisting condition. That is an "insurance transferability" problem.

Our Hussein wanted to do this in the name of "Equality". Apparently he neither has problem with preaching "equality" in the morning, and throw a \$400,000 state dinner at night, nor he ever heard Winston Churchill's lamentation of "Socialism is a philosophy of failure, the creed of ignorance, and the gospel of envy, its inherent virtue is the equal sharing of misery".

As "Step 1)" on the flowchart, instead of looking at the current insurance system's obvious problems (the aforementioned transferability, or tort reform, or "purchasing insurance from across state line), they decided they create the perfect, "dreamlike" (of which everyone but Obama, that arrogant idiot Ezekiel Emanuel, the FaceLift Quin Nancy Pelosi, the US Senate's chief gangster Harry Reid, and a few other usual morons –the Durbin-Schumer-Menendez-Leahy quartet, knew: it is a nightmare) system, where

- a. Young people, who –by nature- feel invincible will not only buy health insurance, but buy at hugely increased cost, just to support the older folks' insurance, and
- b. The aforementioned "30 million" Americans, most of whom have never cared about insurance will rush to have one.

People, who did not want to work "based upon their abilities" all that much, but they did, just to get insurance. In short, they (as all enthusiastic socialist would do) did everything against basic human nature, and they expected a desired result. They did not get it.

To build the entertainment portion in, they developed (for a mere \$480 million) a web site that would shame a third rate used car dealer in the New Mexico desert. ...and would you believe?? The result was exactly what people with brain predicted.

....so, Obama&Co applied the socialist flowchart's "Step 2)"

There are societies where houseguests have the right to have sex with the woman of the house. These are all social models, learned through upbringing and daily interaction with the society. The reason societies have institutions called "police" and "court system" is to enforce the established social behavior. Keep this "enforcement" component in mind for a moment, we will get back to it.

The other component is that there is no one on the planet who prefers hardship against a pleasant living environment (e.g. I do what I want, when I want). So, if you offer people a pleasant living lifestyle by not working, they will get off work. The "minimum wage is just that": minimum. It conditions people to appreciate more work and more education, for one reason, and one reason only: to further their life conditions. To have a better life. This conditions people, drives people toward bettering themselves. People around me say I am a workaholic, but I am here to tell you: give me \$30,000/month, and I will take the speed way back, will do what I love to do, whenever I feel like doing it.

These are the two, most basic gene-level "human element" components which will be present so long as the human animal populates the planet. Based upon them, it is not only easy, but highly rational, common sense and at the level of "my goat understood it" to conclude, that humans must be continuously channeled to a certain direction, otherwise —as a result of the "basic human element"- they will go back to act based upon their born, gene-level instincts: they will look for the easy life.

So, to tie things together, we can say, that a human animal is conditioned from birth, by parents, teachers, schools, coaches, Boy and Girl Scouts, by the church, workplaces, and other entities, in order to make them behave like a river; stay within a defined channel (aka "social behavior") and continuously flow forward (aka "advance themselves"). The two shorelines of the "river bend" are the "police" and the "court system" dealing with the "overflow". "Study hard for better grade", "train ten hours a day, every day to achieve your Olympic dream" "minimum wage", "working hard to support yourself while in school", "working in two jobs to support your family", and many other "work/reward" components are all part of the same "life enforcement" paradigm.
