"African Americans" and Other Matters

I've been thinking about this for a long time. The first time I did was when I ran into a friend of mine, from South Africa, born and raised in Johannesburg. He is Dutch origin, tall, blond, blue eyes; all underlined his statement: "I think I am the first African American you have ever met". The second of my three piece puzzle was my visit to St. Lucia, a Caribbean Island; roughly 80%-20% black/white population. And, of course the "ever-lasting third piece" is squarely occupied by people such as Ali Sharpton, Jesse Jackson, B. Hussein Obama, Elijah Cummings, Henry Waxman, Charlie Wrangleand others (let's call them the "Last Option Team, or 'LOT'") and their garbage they have been jamming down the (sufficiently dumb) public's throat.

island. If Charles said "I will be there at 9:00am", he was not there at 8:58; he was there at 9:00. Beside all the positive attributes they showed us, there were two, which towered over everything else: their dignity and their pride doing the particular job they were doing.

Now, since I know readers coming from American public schools under the concept of "outcome based education" still do not get where I am going with this, let me formulate it real quick.

- Apparently (according to LOT), American blacks die hungry, cannot get cloths on their back and they will permanently live on the streets if the government did not help them from cradle to grave.  - The baggage carousel got stuck from a piece of luggage –it took someone 20 min to show up;
 - We went to a restaurant (you know, a few tables, maybe a TGI level if I am pushing it) found probably six tables unoccupied (representing 50% of the capacity). The white waitress was standing a front of it, telling us "you need to wait a few minutes for an available table". I said "Honey, I see six". Listen to the reply, because I have not heard this one in 61 years: "Those are for parties of three or four" (while there was no one beside us) –we left her standing there, not understanding what is our problem.
 - We went to another one, exclusively labored by Hispanics. The non-service, the arrogant ignorance were through the roof ---if you were white. Because all of them were very kind and service oriented to each other and to people who spoke Spanish.

Now, let me string this together, so even liberals and outcome-base education alumni will understand it.

- While community organizer conmen such as Hussein Obama, and hate merchant street rats such like Ali Sharpton making a fine living on
