

## Letter to Secretary Kerry

April 11, 2015

Dear Mr. Secretary;

It is my belief, that Appearance, Abilities, Experience, Intelligence, Knowledge and one's jobs or other activities are in a circular reference to each other; sort of a two sides of the coin.

Appearance: photo models must be beautiful;  
Abilities: as a coach, you would not pick a overweight person for your high-jump team;  
Experience: you want to have a surgeon do your heart operation with several thousand surgeries under his belt;  
Intelligence: you try to find a highly intelligent (which is vastly different from "educated") person to represent you in a negotiation
