....or Germany, Germany Above All ...

And this says it all. I have been the inventor and a long time (unpopular) proponent of the thesis of "There is not another country and culture in the world where Hitler could have pulled his Nazi system off." This brought us to today. Please read the Wall Street Journal 9/14 piece (bold and highlight by me):

"...Germany started imposing document checks for people entering the country Sunday, seeking to stem the tide of migrants streaming in by suspending a cornerstone of European integration: open borders. The temporary border controls— announced on the eve of a European Union interior ministers' meeting on Monday to find measures to cope with the escalating migration crisis—came as a warning shot to other countries in the bloc. It indicated that Germany, the EU's largest country and top destination for refugees and other migrants, was prepared to undermine Europe's treaty on passportfree travel if other countries didn't take in more of the hundreds of thousands of people arriving from the Middle East and elsewhere in search of a better and safer life.

Calling the move "a signal to Europe," German Interior Minister Thomas de Maizière said that the government "will live up to its humanitarian responsibility. But <u>the burden connected with the large</u> number of refugees must be distributed in solidarity throughout Europe."

The decision is an abrupt reversal from Germany's decision to fling open its doors just over a week ago, when it and Austria agreed to allow in thousands of migrants being held back by authorities in Hungary. .... "Europe's idleness in the migrant crisis is starting to push Germany close to its limits," Economics Minister Sigmar Gabriel told the newspaper Der Tagesspiegel in an interview published on Sunday. ... In recent months, Europe's open internal borders have meant that refugees and migrants arriving by boat on the shores of Italy and Greece have been streaming toward Germany, drawn by its healthy economy and generous social benefits. ... On Sunday, the German government temporarily shut off all train traffic to and from its southeastern neighbor Austria and ordered federal police to help secure borders in the southern German state of Bavaria. ... German national railway Deutsche Bahn said train services to and from Austria were suspended for 12 hours, at the request of German federal authorities, on Sunday afternoon.....Hungary and several other countries have so far opposed both plans, arguing that guotas would only attract more migrants and that border protection should be EU's first priority. German officials want other countries to contribute more resources of their own to responding to the migration crisis. Berlin has been insisting that EU member states where most migrants enter the bloc register them, as existing bloc rules mandate. But it is also pushing for new rules that would distribute migrants more evenly across the bloc.

"Those who seek asylum must accept that they cannot simply choose which member state of the European Union offers them refuge," Mr. de Maizière said. ...The move also comes after a cry for help from Bavaria, a conservative stronghold and the state that has handled most of the arriving migrants over the past days. There has been growing domestic criticism elsewhere of Ms. Merkel's decision to open the doors...."

Let me translate this for you:

- Germany has been very big on "follow the rules." They used this line with the Greeks probably 66,000 times over the last 4 years.
- In this "migration" case, Germany created the situation by opening the doors to "all Syrians";
- Then, they effectively suspended the Dublin Act,...
- They dumped the entire problem (dealing with migrants) into the lap of Hungary, Italy, Greece, Rumania and Croatia....
- They endangered the welfare of Austria.

• They caused a problem no one has seen since the 1940s; over the last two weeks, there were time periods when there was no train service between Hungary and Austria and Germany...

...and the situation started to be clear even for the Germans when Munich was effectively shut down.
