

Letter To Dan Henninger

February 17, 2020

Dear Mr. Henninger,

I've been a long time admirer and follower of your work (I wish the entire WSJ was half of your quality). My bone fides include the correct prediction of Brexit, the last two Popes (both by name), and President Trump's election (I also used "Obama" and "socialist" in the same sentence approx. six months before Rush Limbaugh).

The reason I am writing this, to expand on my prediction (March 19, 2019) of the Bernie Sanders - Amy Klobuchar ticket (http://www.mygoatopined.com/Writings/19-03.20_2020_What_2020.pdf). To validate the prediction (put a time stamp on it), I sent an email and the attached paper to Ms. Strassel (another great light in WSJ's darkness) at that time. I'm sure I'm not too far by saying: in March 2019, I was the only one in this country predicting that ticket.

As an expansion of the prediction:

- When Warren collapses, 85% of her votes will go to Sanders
- When Biden collapses, 30% of his vote will go to Sanders (or to Warren, then Sanders; it depends which collapses first)
- Buttigieg will collapse once the primary roadshow will reach middle-America. It is not the evaluation of his quality (which would be another discussion; he doesn't have the quality to be president), and not the fact he is gay. It is the fact that America (except some places on the east and west coasts) will not vote for a gay person as president
- When Buttigieg collapsed, roughly 10% of his block will go to Sanders
- In spite of experts' opinion, Warren is not an "enemy of Sanders" she is a "vote safe keeper" for him: the longer she stays, the surer is that most (or: all) her votes will go to Sanders
- Besides Bloomberg will not be the nominee, he would never make it through the general election:
 - Sanders people will stay home
 - Blacks won't vote for him
 - Several unions won't vote for him
 - His spineless turn around on major issues will turn a lot of voters off, and give Trump more than enough ammo
 - Sanders will have a field day with him as someone buying election
 - Trump kill him on "buying election". Trump has a great story to tell: he spent 30% of the money Clinton did. He did not buy election and he went to every primary; Bloomberg jumps in late, waves his money around and tries to buy election. He will soon discover it doesn't work that way.
- The idea (Drudge) that Bloomberg picks Hillary Clinton shows how scared Bloomberg is; he knows (more than the "experts" and the media) how thin ice he is walking on. He knows his entire "campaign" is a farce. He wants to add the women votes through Clinton. Among many problems Bloomberg is facing: the Durham investigation is not over, and the mud most likely will splash on Clinton from there. Bloomberg knows this and he still takes the chance. This is how scared he is about his chances.
- Beside Sanders will win the nomination, the constant mistake "experts" and media makes is the parallel between Trump and Sanders; *"Sanders probably has a ceiling. But, we thought candidate Trump has a ceiling."* The major difference (which sets these two a world apart) that Trump represented the American Idea. Sanders represents the Soviet Idea. The source of Sanders' expansion is how dumb the left electorate is becoming (and getting dumber).

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Sanders' total voting block = his + 80% of Warren's + 30% of Biden's + 10% of Buttigieg's = ~30%-34% of the total US electorate. It's enough for "second place" in the general election.

I strongly believe (in fact I am convinced, and I have been preaching this for several decades) my thesis of *"60%-70% of every society is an unable to think, clueless moron, can be taken to any point of the political spectrum"* is something no "expert" has ever used as a factor. 99% of the national media has done the same (with the rare exception of Lew Dobbs). The thesis has never been true anywhere in the world more than it is in the today's USA. The fact that a 78 year old self admitted socialist senile nut job is cheered by 30% of the total electorate of the United States of America says it all.
